Trick-or-Treat



Halloween DOs and DON'Ts can be used to teach the rules of trick-or-treating during Halloween time. Many children with social communication disorders do not understand the "hidden rules" for trick-or-treating. This activity was created to help children learn the basic rules for trick-or-treating.

Suggested activities:

- Brainstorm "hidden rules" for trick-or-treat before showing the list of DOs and DON'Ts.
- 2. After brainstorming, check the list to see how many your child was able to name.
- 3. Go through each page and look at the pictures and answer the questions.
- 4. Role play trick-or-treating and the rules with your child BEFORE Halloween night.

Rules for Trick-or-Treat

D0



- Walk
- Stay with your group
- Only go to houses with the porch light ON
- Knock on the door
- Wait
- When a person opens the door say "trick or treat"!
- Let the person give you candy
- Say "thank you"
- Let adults check your candy before you eat it!





- Run
- Walk away from group
- Go to houses with the porch light OFF
- Open the door
- Forget to wait
- Forget to say "trick or treat"
- Grab candy
- Forget to say "thank you"
- Eat your candy before an adult checks it
